Guidelines

Inclement Weather: If lightning is in the area, you will be warned by our lightning prediction system. If you hear one long 15-second blast of the horn, seek shelter indoors immediately. Three short 5-second blasts of the horn indicate the storm has moved out of the area, and it is safe to resume outdoor activities. If you remain outdoors after the warning sound, you do so at your own risk.

Food & Drink: Fogg Café is open every day.

Accessibility: Scooters are available for a fee, and wheelchairs are available for guest use at no charge, on a first-come, first-served basis.




